PRACTICAL NOTE

The Anti-doping seminar "Preventing Doping in Professional and in Grassroots Sport through Education and Investigation" is going to be held under the Bulgarian Presidency of the Council of the EU, co-funded by the European Programme Erasmus+ and will take place on 24th and 25th January 2018 in Sofia, Bulgaria.

Delegation Format

The format of the EU MS delegations is 1 Government Official + 1 National Anti-doping Organisation representative. Other representatives from International Governmental and Non-Governmental Organisations working in the field as well as Non-EU countries representatives are also invited.

Accommodation

The Bulgarian Presidency of the Council of the European Union will cover the accommodation for two nights of one expert per country (NADO representative) on 23rd and 24th January 2018.

Extra accommodation is not covered.

All other delegates are kindly asked to cover the costs of their own accommodation.

The Bulgarian Presidency of the Council of the European Union will provide transportation from Sofia International Airport to Hotel Marinela Sofia and back for all participants.



Taxis are available directly outside the Arrivals Hall at Sofia International Airport 24 hours a day. A taxi service booth is situated in the Arrivals Hall. Make sure that you check the prices of a particular taxi BEFORE you enter the car to <u>avoid taxi</u> scams.

Approximate taxi fee in Sofia:

- Initial Charge: 0.60 0.90 lv. (0.30 0.45 EUR)
- Daytime rate per km (6am 10pm): 0.79 0.90 lv. (0.35–0.45 EUR per km)
- Nighttime rate per km (10pm 6am): 0.70 0.99 lv. (0.35–0.50 EUR per km)
- Waiting rate: 0.24 lv. per minute (0.12 EUR / min.)
- Call-out charge: 0.90 lv. (0.25 0.45 EUR)


Dinner

220V ±10% electrical supply. Supply frequency is 50Hz.


Plug socket in use is the two-pinned Type F, also known as "Schuko".

Climate

Bulgaria is located in Southeast Europe, in the northeast part of the Balkan Peninsula. The winter temperatures may get down to -20°C.







Tourism

Bulgaria is proud of its pristine nature and amazing biodiversity, which is preserved in the mountains, parks and nature reserves. The country occupies only 2% of Europe's territory but with more than 40 000 cultural monuments and artefacts, it is in third place in Europe. Seven of them are included in the UNESCO List of World Cultural Heritage Sites. This includes prehistoric artefacts, Thracian and Roman heritage, historical monuments from the First and the Second Bulgarian Kingdoms, and architectural landmarks from the Age of Bulgarian Renaissance. As a recognition of its ancient cultural heritage, Plovdiv was selected as 2019 European Capital of Culture.

Traditionally known for its sun, sand and sea, the Bulgarian seaside also offers hiking, biking, golf, yachting and visits to natural, cultural and archaeological sites. The country is one of the most popular skiing destinations in the Balkans with its major ski resorts Bansko, Borovets and Pamporovo.

The healing power of mineral springs has been used since the time of the Thracians and the Romans. With more than 600 healing mineral thermal spas, healing climate and curative mud, Bulgaria is a competitive and medical spa destination. Mineral springs located in the southern part of the country are influenced by the Mediterranean climate, other springs are also found in mountain regions and along the Black Sea coast.
